Class 1

Class One are learning all about Mini-beasts. We are delving into the world of tiny creatures and have set up a wormery in the classroom and are building our own bug hotel to attract more creatures in the learning garden.



Class 2

Class 2 are looking forward to our first Summer half term and it is looking to be another busy one. We are going to be learning lots of exciting things in our topic of the seaside, answering the question 'What can you see beside the sea?' We are also looking forward to taking part in dance workshops with Katie from Bell Dance academy. We are all set for another busy, fun filled half term!

Class 3

Class Three we are looking forward to learning all about the Stone Age. We will be reading the book 'Stig of the dump' and we will continue to work on the 'Fractions' for year 4 and starting 'Statistics' for year 3. In Science, Year 3 will be learning about types of rocks, grouping rocks, fossils and soil formation. Meanwhile, Year 4 will be learning about States of Matter where they will find out about solids, liquids and gases. As well as heating and cooling, evaporation and the water cycle.

Class 4

Class 4 are very excited about our new topic - Ancient Egypt. We are currently learning about the importance of the River Nile and why it was called the 'lifeline' of the Egyptian Civilisation. We will also learn all about the process of mummification, the afterlife, Egyptian beliefs and way of life.

We are also continuing to read our whole class novel, 'The Girl of Ink and Stars'. In Science, we are learning about forces and their impact on objects. In P.E, we are learning fielding and batting techniques ready for rounders soon!
